PROPOSED INTEGRATED MATERIALS PERFORMANCE EVALUATION PROGRAM  
SCHEDULES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2022–2024 (STC-21-024)

**Purpose:** To inform Agreement States of upcoming Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program (IMPEP) reviews and to solicit comments on the proposed schedule for fiscal years (FY) 2022 through 2024.

**Background:** Annually, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) provides the projected IMPEP schedule to ensure that Agreement States have advanced notice of upcoming IMPEP reviews. The proposed FY 2022 schedule includes several IMPEP reviews that were postponed due to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) public health emergency (PHE). The NRC will continue monitoring the situation and adjust, as appropriate, the proposed IMPEP schedule to account for challenges associated with the COVID-19 PHE.

**Discussion:** The NRC is soliciting comments<sup>1</sup> on the enclosed proposed IMPEP review schedule and requests comments within 30 days from the date of this letter. The NRC will strive to address comments on the proposed IMPEP schedule, as appropriate, and post the draft schedule on the IMPEP Toolbox Portal (<https://scp.nrc.gov/impeptools.html>).
